Recommendations:

1. **Handling and storage:** Storage in cool environments, do not hit the package, do not expose to high temperatures, keep away from sources of heat. Failure to comply with the previous procedures could generate heating, fire and explosion.
2. **If the package is damaged,** special procedures must be followed. If the condition is safe, perform the inspection and change the package if necessary.
3. **In case of heating or fire:** Use plenty of water or a non-flammable liquid.
4. **Waste disposal:** It is considered dangerous goods, therefore dispose according to the regulations of each country.
